Repair Program and Aging in Place

Repair Program

- The work is done by volunteers under qualified supervision.
- We serve those who own their own home, with limited income, but with some ability to contribute to the cost.
- Homeowners share in the cost as they are able and provide "sweat equity" by participating in the project.
- We do simple interior and exterior repairs and some roof repairs after inspection.
- We do not do mold remediation.

Examples: replace broken hardware or light fixtures, install a new window or door, repair porches, steps and decks
